[LEGS](#) is a set of international standards and guidelines for livestock interventions that assist people affected by disasters. Through training, publishing, advocacy, and dialogue, we promote these standards worldwide, working through our global community of practice.

LEGS started life as a project in 2005 and became a UK-registered charity in 2018. We are now looking to build a team of five trustees with a diverse profile and skill set. Ideally two of the five will be based outside the UK.

Trustees will have one or more of the following:

- Experience of charity governance
- Experience of humanitarian programming and a commitment to this being locally led
- Familiarity with the livestock sector in developing countries
- Professional expertise in any of the following areas:
 - Fundraising
 - human resource development
 - financial management

All trustees ensure that LEGS fulfils its statutory duties as a charity.

The trustee role is voluntary. In return, you will have an opportunity to support and guide an innovative, committed, and well-respected organisation into the next stage of its development.

Trustee meetings are held every quarter on a virtual platform and last no more than half a day. Trustees serve for an initial two-year period, renewable by mutual consent.
